Teams will work with SIFAT graduate Pastor Raul on the project known as Jesus es el Camino (Jesus is the Way). We will finish the second floor of the addition started in 2015 that will house a kitchen, cafeteria and classrooms.

Through the efforts of Pastor Raul's church, Iglesia del Nazareno, and their partnership with Compassion International, these children will be tutored in their school subjects, encouraged in their spiritual development, fed a hot lunch, and, most importantly, have a place to be safe and off the streets while their parents work, usually far away from home. Each construction team will also have a VBS component branching out into five different marginalized areas of Quito teaching very poor children about the love of Jesus.

Medical and dental teams are needed to continue providing medical care to the women and children in each of the communities around Quito in which we serve.

Project Location: Calderon, in Quito at an altitude of 9,500 ft.

Length of Trip: 8 days (Saturday to Saturday). Additional full days are available at \$81 per day. For flights leaving Quito after 5 p.m., the hotel will charge an additional \$50.

Lodging: In Quito, Hotel Tambo Real - downtown Quito near many interesting sites. Double or triple rooms with private baths with hot water, linens and towels provided, free internet service. Single rooms are available for an additional cost.

Transportation: Travel by 22-35 passenger buses.

Cost per person: \$1015 in-country expenses for 8 days/7 nights, plus \$850-\$1400 approximate round-trip airfare depending on the airline and time of travel.

Construction Team Project Cost: \$2500 per team or \$100 per person, whichever is greater.

Medical Team: \$125 per person, for additional translators and medical health care training fund. Medical teams provide medications and medical supplies.

* Tourist day activities are not included in team costs. A list of activities and their costs are available from the team coordinator. Costs are approximately an additional \$85—\$100 per person.
