Agape’s plan for self-sustainability depends on ACA becoming a government-accredited secondary boarding school, which offers the three highest grades, the “O” level in Uganda. To achieve this goal, we must hire certified teachers, build a government-approved science lab and finish dormitories for 250 students right away. We cannot reach this goal without your financial support.

Tuition from the boarding school ultimately will help provide the \$6,000 per month that it costs for Agape to operate. This includes all salaries, food, firewood, utilities, school supplies, communications, tuition for the Agape primary school students and full-time support for the 45 Agape-sponsored orphans.

Currently, sponsors give monthly to support individual children living at Agape. This does not cover the total cost of operating the school and orphanage. We ask you to invest in the lives of these children by becoming a sponsor of Agape Total Childcare Center and Christian Academy.
